TEACH US ABOUT: MICROSOFT FLIGHT SIMULATOR

Microsoft Flight Simulator is a series of amateur flight simulator programs for Microsoft Windows operating system. It is one of the longest-running, best-known, and iconic home flight simulator programs on the market, and one of the longest running PC video game series of all time.

In November 2022 the game will be celebrating its 40-year anniversary making it also the longest-running software product line for Microsoft, predating Windows by three years.

New players will learn how to take off, fly and land a plane. The tutorials will also educate players on Visual Flight Rules, which help them reach their destination.

The main reasons we enjoy playing this game are the advanced graphics it has, the in-depth information about the types of aeroplanes and the opportunity of discovering and completing missions at different cities and locations around the world.

NEWS: THE NATIONAL DAY OF SPAIN.

On Wednesday October 12th, Spain celebrated its National day, which its central event is the military parade that takes place on Paseo de la Castellana in Madrid, presided over by King Felipe VI.

More than 4,000 soldiers, more than a hundred motor vehicles, 26 helicopters and 58 planes participated in the traditional parade, with thousands of people in attendance gathering along the route.

The day coincides with the commemoration of the historical day when Christopher Columbus first discovered the Americas on the same day in 1492. It symbolises Spain's vast common heritage with today's American Countries, which made up the Spanish Empire, the first global power in world history.
