NEWS: THE NEW ZEALAND FLOODS.

Regions across the upper North Island of New Zealand experienced widespread catastrophic floods caused by heavy rainfall, with Auckland, the country's biggest city, being the most significantly affected. More than a month of rain had fallen in 24 hours in Auckland on the 27th January affecting 25 suburbs in the city, closed major motorways, and left 6,000 to 8,000 homes in need of damage assessment.



NEWS: EARTHQUAKE IN TURKEY.

A powerful 7.8 magnitude earthquake hit southern and central Turkey and northern and western Syria on Monday 6th february, resulting in widespread damage, 19,400 casualties and more than 70,000 injured.

The earthquake was felt as far as Egypt, Israel, Palestine, Lebanon, Cyprus, and the Black Sea coast of Turkey. There were more than 10,000 aftershocks in the three weeks that have followed. Search and rescue teams were immediately dispatched to the affected area and the national government declared a level four alert to appeal for international aid.
